Installing “WPFeedsCash”.

Installing the plugin is like installing any other WP plugin.

Step 1: Go to the "Plugins" section and click.

Step 2: Click "Add New" and Upload the included zip file.

Step 3: Activate "WPFeedsCash".

Using “WPFeedsCash”.

After activating the plugin, create a New post as you usually do.

Now you'll find a **box** from where **you can create an ad** for this specific post (each post can have - or not - an ad that will be only visible on Your RSS Feeds).

Here you can see this area and the 3 steps to create an ad:



Each ad consists of:

- 1) An Image Link
- 2) A Text Link
- 3) A URL (Your Image & Your Text Link Will Point To This Url).

Some comments:

- If you don't want to use an image for your ad, just don't upload an image.
- The same if you don't want to use a text link, just leave the "Text" field in blank.
- Your link can point to any url (affiliate link etc), just make sure that it begins with http://

Where Can I Find My RSS Feeds?

Your WordPress Feeds url is under the **"/feed"** directory of the site where you've installed wordpress. Example:

<http://www.yoursite.com/feed>

Comment: If you have problems to see your RSS Feeds, try using a browser like "FireFox". If you still can't find it, then your wp theme or wp settings may have changed the url of your rss feeds.

If you want to see the changes that you make to your RSS Feeds, remember to "Update" (or Publish) your post after making changes to it.

Then go to your feeds url and press F5 to see the updates.

That's all!
